NOTE: Twelve-to-Eighteen month class is not a puppy class and requires an adult entry fee.

***Amateur-Owner-Handler** – For dogs that are at least six months of age that are not champions. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog and is limited to exhibitors who have not, at any point in time, been a professional dog handler, AKC approved conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler (effective January 1, 2009).

NON-REGULAR CLASSES – INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

Veteran Dog Class: A class for Dogs seven (7) years or older

Veteran Bitch Class: A class for Bitches seven (7) years or older.

Note: Chapter 11, Section 8 of the Dog Show Rules provides that castrated males may be entered in the Veteran Dog Class and spayed females may be entered in the Veteran Bitch Class at independent Specialties.

Non-Regular (Additional) Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries

Stud Dog Class: For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Get must be entered in another class at this show. It is not necessary for the Get to be under the same ownership as the Stud Dog. Stud Dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and shown in the ring with his Get. The merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry. The class will be judged on the merits of the Get. Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification under AKC Dog Show Rules. The Stud Dog shall be considered one entry and requires one entry fee, this being the regular fee plus the additional fee if the Stud Dog is entered in another class.

Brood Bitch Class: Same as Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

Note: Chapter 11, Section 8 of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows provides that castrated males and spayed bitches are allowed to be entered in Stud Dog or Brood Bitch.

Brace Class: A brace is defined as two dogs of the same recognized breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner. Dogs comprising a Brace must be named at the time of entry. BOTH DOGS MUST BE ENTERED IN ANOTHER CLASS.

If a dog is entered in more than one class at the show, the recording fee is to be collected on the first entry only" Ch. 11, Section 2, AKC Dog Show Rules.

ALL EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT FEES IN US FUNDS. No Cash.

No entry may be sent by any method that requires a signature for delivery.

Entry fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of a Show Committee.

Post dated checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The PWCCR will add a collection fee of \$25.00 to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in them being put on a CASH ONLY basis. No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strike and/or any other cause beyond the control of the PWCCR or Show Secretary.

Due to the costs of processing, refunds of \$3.00 or less will not be made.

No entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees or signatures. There are no refunds for duplicate entries. The Show Secretary will make every effort to find duplicate entries, but if an entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form.

Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to the close of entries. No dog wrongly entered in a class may be transferred to another class (except in case of wrong sex), nor can a dog be withdrawn after entries have closed. The owner or agent assumes all responsibilities for wrong or incomplete information in the entry blanks.

Neither the Club, nor the Show Secretary will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.

The Club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value. All prizes must be claimed the day of the show, none will be mailed.
